विषय: स्वतंत्र सेवा प्रदाताओं के संबंध में कार्गो हैंडलिंग, ग्राउन्ड हैंडलिंग एवं हवाईजहाज में फ्यूल सप्लाई संबंधित सवाओं के लिए मौजूदा टैरिफ को 30.09.2025 तक जारी रखने की अंतरिम व्यवस्था।

Subject: Interim arrangement to levy the existing tariffs in respect of Cargo Facility, Ground Handling and Supply of Fuel to the Aircraft (CGF) Services provided by the Independent Service Providers for further period up to 30.09.2025.

AERA, vide Order No.10/2024-25 dated 26th September, 2024 inter-alia, allowed the following Independent Service Providers (ISPs) to levy the then prevailing tariffs, in respect of the services relating to Cargo Facility, Ground Handling & Supply of Fuel to the Aircraft, on interim basis, for a period of 06 (six) months w.e.f. 01.10.2024 to 31.03.2025, or, till the determination of regular tariff for their respective control periods, whichever is earlier:

2. Further, the Authority, vide separate interim Tariff Orders had also approved ad-hoc tariffs for the following ISPs in respect of Cargo Facility, as an interim measure, up to 31.03.2025, or, till the determination of regular tariff for their respective control periods, whichever is earlier.

3. The tariff determination exercise for some of the aforementioned Independent Service Providers is currently under progress and MYTPs from the remaining ISPs are yet to be received. Hence, it will take some time for the determination of regular tariffs for the ISPs mentioned in the above tables. Meanwhile, as an interim measure, the Authority decides that the Independent Service Providers, as per the above tables, may be allowed to continue to levy the prevailing tariffs (applicable as on 31.03.2025), for a further period of six (06) months, w.e.f. 01.04.2025 to 30.09.2025, or, till the determination of regular Tariffs for the aforesaid service providers, whichever is earlier.

ORDER

In view of the above, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred under the Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that: -

- (i) The **Independent Service Providers** providing services relating to Cargo Facility/ Ground Handling/ Supply of Fuel to the Aircraft at the various Major Airports as per the above Table 'A' and 'B' are allowed to levy the existing tariffs (applicable as on 31.03.2025), for a further period of six (06) months effective from **01.04.2025 to 30.09.2025**, or, till the determination of regular tariffs for the abovementioned ISPs, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The Airport Operators to ensure timely submission of MYTPs by the concerned Independent Service Providers operating at their respective major airports.
- (iii) The Airport Operators, shall publish this interim order with respect to aforementioned ISPs at their official websites for the information of all Stakeholders.

(iv) The Airport Operators to ensure compliance of this Order.

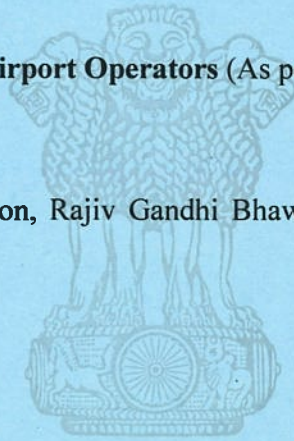

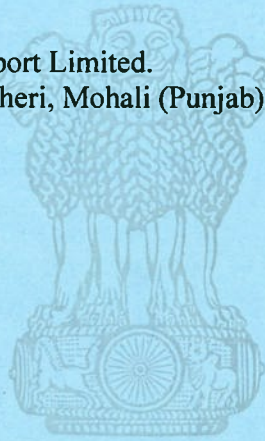

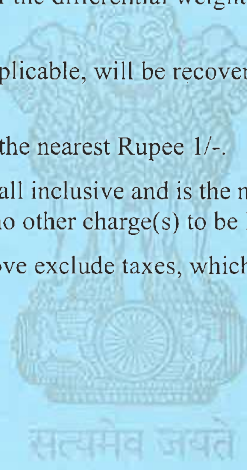

1. For the purpose of levy of Demurrage Charges, the Free Period allowed for Export Cargo to Agents/ Shippers/ Exporters shall be as per the Govt. of India Orders, issued from time to time. Presently, Free Period allowed to Exporters/Shippers for Export Cargo is 12 Hrs.
2. Charges will be on the "Gross Weight" or the "Chargeable Weight" of Consignment, whichever is higher. Wherever the "Gross Weight" and (or) volume weight is wrongly indicated on the AWB and is actually found more, Charges will be levied on the "Actual Gross Weight" or the "Actual Volumetric Weight", whichever is higher.
3. Special Cargo consist of perishable and temperature sensitive products, live animals, hazardous goods, valuables and / or any other such cargo which requires/have special handling/ storage instructions.
4. For mis declaration of weight above 2 % and up to 5% of declared weight penal charges double the applicable TSP Charges will be levied. For variation above 5% the penal charges will be five times the applicable TSP charges of the differential weight. No Penal charges will be there for variation up to and inclusive 2%.
5. Customs' Cost Charges, if applicable, will be recovered separately on actuals, in addition to above Charges.
6. All bills to be rounded off to the nearest Rupee 1/-.
7. The Tariff indicated above is all inclusive and is the maximum Charges to be levied to Users of the cargo handling services and no other charge(s) to be levied over and above approved Tariff.
8. All the Charges indicated above exclude taxes, which will be charged extra at the prevailing rates.

1. Demurrage Charges will be levied to Airlines if Customs Cleared Cargo is stored in the Warehouse beyond the Free Period allowed in case of Export Cargo. The Free Period for Airlines in respect of the Export Cargo shall be as per the Govt. of India Orders, issued from time to time. Presently, Free Period allowed to Airlines for Export Cargo is 36 Hrs.
2. Charges will be on the “Gross Weight” or the “Chargeable Weight” of Consignment, whichever is higher. Wherever the “Gross Weight” and (or) volume weight is wrongly indicated on the AWB and is actually found more, Charges will be levied on the “Actual Gross Weight” or the “Actual Volumetric Weight”, whichever is higher.
3. In case of Premium Service request, such service shall be provided at a premium of 25% over the normal Handling rates.
4. Miscellaneous Charges includes special service requests from the customers other than the services already mentioned in the above tariff chart.
5. Customs’ Cost Charges, if applicable, will be recovered separately on actuals, in addition to above Charges.
6. The Tariff indicated above is all inclusive and is the maximum Charges to be levied to Users of the cargo handling services and no other charge(s) to be levied over and above approved Tariff.
7. All the Charges indicated above exclude taxes, which will be charged extra at the prevailing rates.
